During this workshop, educators take a deeper look at systemic inequalities, traditional educator dispositions about students of color, and community systems that impact the educational outcomes of students of color. It informs educators how to respect, use, and understand culture to enhance school design and learning experiences that result in successful academic and social outcomes for students of color. Using videos, movement-based activities, songs, laughter, and sometimes tears, this workshop will increase the capacity of participants to improve the life and educational outcomes of students of color by creating Educational Equity environments.
